Minutes of the 2019 Members' Meeting Teleconference Call

Approved July 7, 2020

The 2019 Meeting of the Members of the Alpha Chi Sigma Educational Foundation was held via teleconference on Friday, December 27, 2019.

President Jennifer Showerman called the meeting to order at 11:02 a.m. EST. Present were officers President Jennifer Showerman, Vice President Randy Weinstein, Secretary-Treasurer John E. Adams, and Assistant Secretary Michael Heilman; and members Robert E. Stevens, Sherrie E. Settle, DeWayne C. Gerber, Charles Carroll, D. Mitch Levings, and Abbey DeGraffenreid.

1. Secretary-Treasurer Adams announced that proxies had been received from 13 of the 17 members. The 7 of these members who were present rescinded their proxies and exercised their right to vote in person. (Proxies were not received from 3 of the officers present, and an additional 5 members who submitted proxies were not present.) A quorum (15 members present in person or by proxy) therefore did exist and business was authorized.

2. VOTED: on a motion by Settle, seconded by Levings, to approve the minutes of the July 27, 2018 Members' Meeting as corrected. [*unanimous*]

3. The Secretary-Treasurer reported on the status of the Foundation's funds as of November 30, 2019, and commented on the Foundation's balance sheet. Adams also reviewed the performance of the Foundation's investments to date, the assets having appreciated by approximately \$93,000 since December 3, 2018.

<u>Mathews Fund</u>: Secretary-Treasurer Adams noted the outstanding Mathews Loans, and indicated that there was no new loan activity over the last year. He also provided an update on the Mathews Loan interest rate, which is set at the subsidized undergraduate Stafford Federal Student Loan rate (4.53% as of 7/1/18; 5.05% for the previous 12 months).
